FUNDING NEED STATEMENT: Community Outreach Programs

DESCRIPTION: Good Samaritan Mission (GSM) provides Community Outreach through Feeding and Clothing Programs. GSM, subject to funding, has increased its commitment to Teton County in 2024.

Community Feeding consists of:

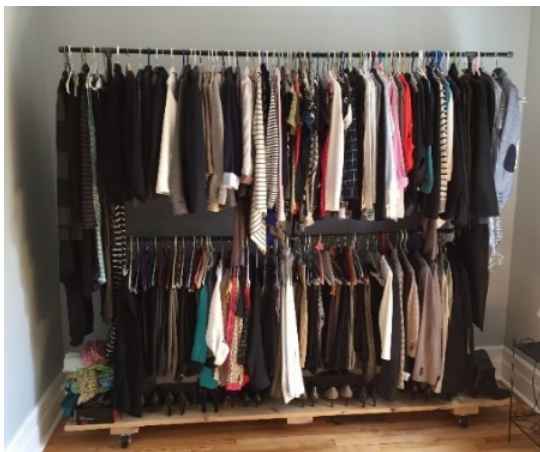
- Breakfast and Dinner Monday-Friday and Breakfast and Lunch Saturday – Sunday 365 days per year to low-income residents of Teton County, Wyoming, and up to 48 GSM shelter clients and staff.
- Onsite Food Pantry 365 days per year to residents of Teton County, Wyoming.

Funding augments food collection from local grocery stores by always having:

- ✓ Ample food for daily meals and Food Pantry distribution.
- ✓ Available produce, meat, and dairy.
- ✓ More healthy options.
- ✓ Client preferences.



Community Clothing “Closet” consists of in-kind clothing donations supplemented by funding which will ensure that sweats, undergarments, and socks are always available in all sizes. The Closet is open to the community and to shelter guests.



TOTAL ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST: \$200,000 (includes food, clothing, community advertising, and staffing)

GSM FUNDRAISING: The Mission has no full-time dedicated staff fundraisers. We fundraise by committee using staff with Board assistance. We also no longer employ fundraising consultants as we have this expertise on staff. In sum, GSM’s fundraising practices and staff expertise ensure that fundraising costs are minimized. In fact, our fundraising cost is far below the 20 cents on the dollar national average at 14 cents.
